Attached are three photos. We currently use Bird-x netting to keep both Birds and Deer from eating our Roses. We are planning to re-do this structure as soon as we find 20 foot pieces of 1/4" or smaller Fiberglas shaft to replace the white pipe. This structure is enclosed with Bird-x netting on the top and sides, dimensions are roughly 15 feet wide, 70 feet long and reaches a height of about 15 feet in the center. If you want an action shot, it'll take a little while to coax a deer into view. Thanks for a great product! We also are using one of the "Scarecrow's" to ward off deer from a flower allegedly not liked by deer. This is the first year we have had the opportunity to see its blooms.
