* Can Animal Repellents That Contain Rotten Egg, Blood, Fish Oil, Meat Meal Attract Omnivores and Carnivores?

United States Department of Agriculture's Wildlife Services Research Study states;

The United States Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Wildlife Services program states that "Many problems with wildlife are caused by attractants left in the yard like pet food, water, bird feeders, fruit, vegetables gardens, and garbage cans."

University of California Research Study States:

"Skunks have a high preference for eggs and that skunks are attracted to residential areas by the ready availability of food, water and shelter." "Raccoons are omnivorous, eating both plants and animals." and "animal foods include crayfish, clams, fish, frogs, snails, insects, turtles, rabbits, muskrats and the eggs and young of ground-nesting birds."

Living With Wildlife Stat

"Raccoons will eat almost anything, but are particularly fond of creatures found in water, clams, crayfish, Frogs, fish and snails." And that "raccoons also eat insects, slugs, dead animals, birds and bird eggs as well as fruits, vegetables, nuts and seeds."

Omnivores are species that eat both plants and animals as their primary food source.
