Avian Control® Repellent is a patent-pending, EPA-registered liquid concentrate designed to repel pest birds from treated areas. When diluted with water and applied according to label directions, it may be fogged, hazed, or sprayed for use across a wide range of agricultural, commercial, and landscape applications.

Avian Control® Repellent is intended to discourage bird presence through contact exposure in treated areas.

### How Avian Control® Repellent Works

Avian Control® Repellent is a contact bird repellent. Target birds must come into contact with treated surfaces or airborne droplets for repellency to occur.

The active ingredient, Methyl Anthranilate (MA), creates a sensory response in birds that encourages avoidance of treated areas. Once birds leave the treated space, the effect diminishes. Over time, birds may associate treated areas with discomfort and reduce repeated use of those locations.

### Target Birds

When used according to the product label, Avian Control® Repellent may be used to repel a broad range of pest birds, including but not limited to:

- Pigeons
- Starlings
- Gulls
- Blackbirds
- Sparrow
- Finch
- Cliff Swallow
- Grackles
- Doves
- Crows
- Waterfowl such as geese, ducks, mute swans, and coots

## Applications

Avian Control® Repellent may be applied, in accordance with label directions, to help discourage birds from:

- Agricultural crops (including fruits, berries, grains, and seeds)
- Turf, grass, and landscaped areas
- Non-fish-bearing water sites for waterfowl deterrence
- Large outdoor or semi-enclosed spaces such as:
  - Parks
  - Golf courses
  - Landfills
  - Corporate and College Campuses
